




TRAFFIC CONTROL PLAN

Full Street Closure26th St






TRAFFIC CONTROL PLAN

AIR QUALITY MONITORING

In compliance with our Dust Control Plans with the Bay Area Air Quality Management District (BAAQMD), we monitor 2 things:

- Dust
- Naturally Occurring Asbestos (NOA)

If there is a detection above an "action level," we investigate & mitigate the cause. The BAAQMD action level is 0.0 16 structures per cubic centimeter.

- Action level is set at this low level to protect public health
- It would take numerous years of daily exposure to have harmful health impacts


